## DNA Profiles

As many of you already know, an AKC issued DNA profile will be a mandatory requirement to enter into any Vizsla Club of America sponsored event starting January 1, 2007. This includes all of the events offered at Nationals (show, field, agility, obedience, etc) as well as regional events. If you don't have a profile, now is the time to get one, as it can sometimes take up to 4 months to get the profile returned to you. Both the National Gun Dog Championship and the VCA Nationals will be held in the Midwest next year, so now is the time to start thinking ahead and get those cheek cells in the mail!

The process is very simple, you can go to the AKC Store at [http://www.akc.org/shop/index.cfm?nav\\_area=online\\_store](http://www.akc.org/shop/index.cfm?nav_area=online_store) and order a pre-paid kit. This will save \$5 off the regular price of \$40. AKC will send you the kit, which consists of the sterile cheek swab, clearly written instructions, mailing pouch, authorization forms, and the return envelope. The kit usually arrives in about two weeks.

When I swabbed and mailed 8 of my dogs at the same time last year, the first profile was received 6 weeks later, the last was received 16 weeks after the date I mailed the samples, so make sure to leave yourself plenty of time to meet the deadlines.
