RE: Breeder Directory Program

Dear Vizsla Club of Illinois Member Breeders,

The Board of Directors is again proud to offer the Breeder Directory to Club members for access by the public.

The language of our Program mirrors the language of our parent organization, the Vizsla Club of America. Member breeders should carefully review the Program language and are required to agree to responsibly adhere to them as a condition of being listed in the Directory.

Inclusion in the Directory is a privilege of being a Club member. As a volunteer organization, we rely on member's help and participation for the operation of the Club. Therefore, as a condition of being listed in the Directory, the Club requires that those participating must fulfill a volunteer requirement prior to being approved for the Directory. Breeders on the Directory must volunteer for the equivalent of a minimum of one full day for the Club. See the page titled "Volunteer Opportunities" for sample opportunities to fulfill this requirement.

The fiscal year for the Program has been changed to commence on July 1 of each year until June 30 of the next, and there will be no additions to the list at other times of the year. Also, no renewal notices will be sent to breeders-it is the individual's responsibility to complete the Application and submit it by June 1 each year. The drawing of the Directory listing order will take place in June at a meeting designated by the Board of Directors at which time volunteer requirement fulfillment and participation approval will be reviewed.

If you are a Club member in good standing and wish to be included in the Directory, complete the "Vizsla Club of Illinois Breeder Listing Application" and submit to the Club Treasurer along with your check. All documents required are available on the VCOI website.
