Dear VCOI Member Breeders,

The Vizsla Club of Illinois Board of Directors has updated the language of our Breeder Referral Website to mirror the language of our parent organization, the Vizsla Club of America. Please review the language in the attached agreement. These are guidelines, however, it is the Club's expectation that breeders on this list, many of whom are also VCA members, will responsibly adhere to them.

In addition, the Club requires that those who wish to list on our Breeder Directory will have fulfilled their volunteer requirement prior to being approved for listing, each year they are listed on the Breeder Directory page. Breeders on the list must serve in the capacity of VCOI Board Officer or Board Member, volunteer to work at least one full day at an event, or serve as a leader of a Club sponsored event or initiative. Please make note of the qualifying event or leadership role on the attached renewal form.

Volunteer requirements must be fulfilled within the twelve (12) month period prior to initial listing or renewal. **Example:** John Doe is applying for initial listing on the Breeder Directory from October 1, 2007 through October 1, 2008. In order to be approved, he will have had to volunteer at least one full day at a VCOI event any time from October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007. When John Doe renews his listing prior to October 1, 2008, he will have had to work at least one full day at a VCOI event between October 1, 2007 and September 30, 2008.

If you would like to renew your listing, please complete the included form and mail it with your check for \$50 payable Vizsla Club of Illinois. Updates to the Directory will continue to be made on the 1st and 15th of each month.

As a Vizsla Breeder on the VCOI list, I/we understand the guidelines and will breed only with the intention of improving the standard as recognized by the American Kennel Club, exhibit soundness, stable temperament and natural hunt ability. I/We understand that only those dogs that have a DNA number and are free of serious hereditary defects (including epilepsy, progressive retinal atrophy, Von Willebrands, entropion and cranial atrophy), and who are over two years of age and have been x-rayed and OFA certified as free from hip dysplasia should be bred. I/We shall not breed, sell, consign puppies or adult dogs to pet shops or other commercial ventures such as lotteries or raffles.

In addition, I/we agree to serve the Club as a volunteer in some leadership capacity, as a VCOI Board Officer, Board Member, leader of an event or Club initiative or a volunteer to on a Club sponsored event/initiative committee for at least one full day.
